

GRADUATE WITH A TBS DEGREE

Graduate with a Toulouse Business School Bachelor in Management after completion of one year at Curtin Mauritius and 2 years at a TBS campus.

Students who wish to enroll onto a TBS Business degree can now start a Bachelor of Commerce degree at Curtin Mauritius. Once they complete the first year at Curtin Mauritius and if they meet the TBS entry requirements, they can apply for entry into a TBS degree at Toulouse or Barcelona campus to complete the second and third year of the degree.

Please note the following:

- Potential students must meet TBS entry requirements. Should aspiring students not meet the TBS requirements or should they wish to remain at Curtin Mauritius, they can continue their studies at Curtin Mauritius and graduate with a Curtin degree.
- The offer is limited to a total of 10 seats within the Barcelona or Toulouse campuses.
- Next intake will be in September 2022.
- The Curtin Mauritius fees will be applicable for the first year and once the student transfers to a TBS campus, the standard international TBS fees will be applicable.
- Curtin programs which will be accepted for this Degree Seeking Track: BCom Management / BCom Management & Marketing / BCom Accounting & Finance.
